Participants will be randomly assigned to either doxycycline or placebo .

Who can participate?

Individuals who:

- Are at least 30 years old
- Are living with HIV
- Have smoking related lung disease

All participants will be in the study for about 72 weeks.

This study includes:

- Pulmonary Function Tests
- CT Scans of the Chest
- Blood Samples
- Questionnaires

This is a voluntary study and all qualified participants will be compensated

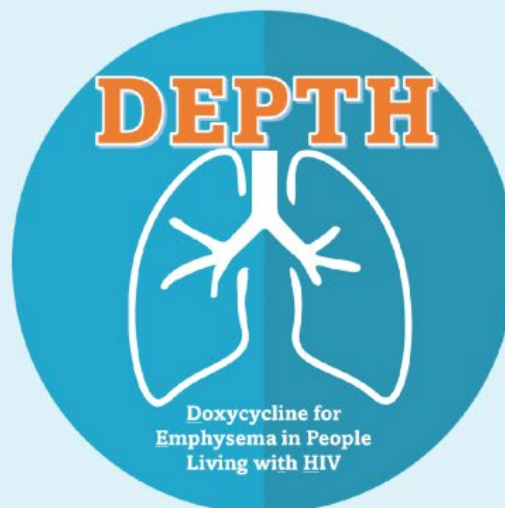
